
Lunch Accounts

PRESCHOOL ATTENDANCE POLICY

All Preschool students are expected to attend school every day. Your child's attendance is a MANDATORY REQUIREMENT in order to participate in this program. Attendance is taken upon arrival every day. As a courtesy, we ask that you contact the school by 8:00 am / 11:30 am if your child will not be attending that day. Since our site is regulated by the state for this program, we are required to report attendance on an ongoing basis. We understand that sometimes your child may be ill or there may be a family situation. We ask that you commit to the following:

- Your child arrives to their session **ON TIME** and are picked up on time.
- You make every effort to schedule doctor appointments before or after your child's session time.
- If you have an appointment and arrive late, please bring a doctor's excuse.
- If your child is absent, you must provide an excuse when they return with the date and reason.


